

## **Instructions for 2011 exam**

This time, the examination tests only for knowledge of the most essential parts of project management. A dictionary is allowed.

The exam consists of 10 questions on project management. By default, there is one question from every knowledge area presented in PMBOK except the procurement management, which is not addressed at all. You will be given a paper consisting of several questions about core concepts, tools, techniques etc. and their use in PM, and you answers should be based on what you have learnt about the subject (either from a book such as PMBOK or according to your experience).

In general terms you are not expected to be able to remember specific points from the course. You are expected to be able to identify and discuss the key issues associated with the project management knowledge areas. We want to test your understanding, not your memory.
